





- In 2012, an international group of neuroscientists signed The Cambridge Declaration on Consciousness: confirmed that many animals, including all mammals and birds, possess the neurological substrates that generate consciousness
- Recognized in many ways: AVMA/Association of Shelter Veterinarians euthanasia guidelines should not be done in front of other animals



The Five Freedoms of Animals

- Established by UK Farm Animal Welfare Council
- · Accepted and adopted by veterinary and animal Associations internationally for a variety of species: Association of Shelter Veterinarians, World Small Animal Veterinary Association, World Organization for Animal Health, RSCPA's, ASPCA, HSUS, etc.
- Renamed <u>The Five Animal Welfare Needs</u> (WSAVA 2019)



The Five Freedoms of Animals

- Freedom from hunger and thirst: by ready access to fresh water and a diet to maintain full health and vigor
- <u>Freedom from discomfort</u>: by providing an appropriate environment including shelter and a comfortable resting area
- Freedom from pain, injury or disease: by prevention or rapid diagnosis and treatment





Freedom from fear and distress: by ensuring conditions and treatment which avoid mental


<u>Freedom to express normal behavior:</u> by providing sufficient space, proper facilities and company of the animal's own kind


The Five Freedoms of Animals

suffering Failure to provide for *any* of these → Suffering


























Outcome

Documented distress, pain
Pled guilty – first conviction based solely on emotional distress
3 yrs prohibition of owning/controlling animals, \$5000 fine

D.C. Case: Lulu

 Lulu, 13 yrs 8 mos old, F/S, brown and white, Jack Russell Terrier; owned by Mr. Sanjay Sitlani

 Videos at apartment complex capture owner physically abusing Lulu

 Videos: 2 different views of lobby and one video on elevator

 Reported by security who witnessed the events in lobby
 Statute: knowingly tortures, torments, cruelly beats





Outcome

He took a plea to misdemeanor animal cruelty
Because no prior criminal record, was given diversion
Conditions included no contact with animals, forfeit ownership of Lulu, no crimes for 6 months, fine of \$500 to DC victims fund
Lulu adopted!





Outcome Pled guilty

- No animal ownership for 3 years
- \$1000 fine Sophie adopted

Consider Suffering In:



- · Tethering, small confinement
- Dog fighting housing, anxiety when taken off
- · Domestic violence cases
